Arriving there about 3 hours before the attack was to be made, he found that the Infant had not yet been within 100 yards of the bridge Nevertheless, he went forward to make his reconnaissance. Expecting to find the bridge mined he therefore looked for leads, which he found and immediately cut, during which operatine was continuously sniped at by enemy snipers. He then went forward to examine the other brigginding the second also mined, and again cut the leads. The next bridge being already seriously damaged, he returned.
