	22nd Bn.	-	Captain Harold Clifton RODDA	<p>At WESTHOEK on 22.9.17 for conspicuous gallantry and courage while commanding a Company.</p> <p>His Company had taken over part of the BLUE LINE and was being subjected to severe and sustained bombardments.</p> <p>This officer moved round from post to post under the heaviest fire greatly inspiring the men by his disregard of danger, his example and his cheerfulness.</p> <p>Later, the same night by initiative in altering the dispositions of his line he was able to take up improved positions thus greatly lessening our casualties.</p> <p>He sets a fine example in coolness and resource and got his men to dig deep sections of trench for their protection in spite of their being greatly fatigued.</p> <p>He has on many occasions displayed great courage and ability and rendered most valuable services while the Battalion was holding the line immediately prior to the attack of 20. 9.17.</p>	<p><i>[Signature]</i> Major-General, Commanding 6th Aust.
