Robert Kenneth BAZELY	<p>For conspicuous gallantry, during the attack at BROODSEINDE on 4th Oct. this Officer acted as Liaison Officer with a flanking Bn. and, when his runners became casualties he continually ran the enemy barrage himself and brought valuable information as to the situation on our flanks.</p> <p>On the 9th Oct. he reconnoitred the J.O.T. in daylight at great risk and later led the attacking troops into position.</p> <p>After the attack he again reconnoitred our new positions and led the relieving Bn. to their line and saw them safely established.</p> <p>This Officer has been in every operation with the Bn. since May 1915 and has always shown the greatest coolness and daring under fire.</p>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Brig.-General, Commanding 6th Aust. He moved continuously amongst his men regardless of danger reorganising them and at Zero led them gallantly forward.</p> <p>He was unfortunately wounded that night in 12 places but refused to be carried finally hobbling back with the assistance of one man.
