On the night Sth/9th Oct. he did similar work on BROODSEINDE RIDGE under particularly heavy fire and throughout the attack on the 9th Oct. he remained in the forward area gathering information and forwarding it to Brigade Headquarters.

This Officer has been on many occasions conspicuous for his gallantry.
