For conspicuous gallantry. On the night of the 3rd/4th Oct. he assisted in laying out Jumping-off and direction tapes at ZONNEBEKE on which the attacking Battalions formed up. He then checked their correctness - This was done under heavy fire. He then helped to guide the attackers to their positions.

On the night 5th/9th Oct. he did similar work on BROODSEINDE RIDGE under particularly heavy fire and throughout the attack on the 9th Oct. he remained in the forward area gathering information and forwarding it to Brigade Headquarters.

This Officer has been on many occasions conspicuous for his gallantry.
