When the 45th R.A. in the position on the road of Lamey under plough fire etc, fear of his men would burn in a dugout went to their rescue and although wounded he paid no thought to himself until they were liberated. 22nd AUSTRALIAN MACHINE GUN COMPANY	292	Ernest Garfield Murray	SERGEANT	During the operations in the vicinity of ZONNEBEKE between the 16th + 17th Oct 1917. 1st Gunner showed great devotion to duty. On the 16th when in charge of a gun team he, despite his inability in handling his men able to keep his displayed under the most trying circumstances his gun accurate. He kept his team working despite firing under very heavy enemy bombardment at 5am, and by his courage at this place he constantly heartened and encouraged his men.	RR	MILITARY MEDAL	1308
