1. Please submit to this office by the 4th January, 1919, nominations on Army Form W.3121, for Roumanian decorations to British Officers and other ranks, in accordance with the allotment shown below.
2. The allotment is based on the Composition of the Forces on the cessation of hostilities. Formations will therefore be responsible for submitting recommendations for the same Units as for the 'Peace Despatch'.
3. An officer or other rank, who has already received a Foreign Decoration on the nomination of the Field-Marshal Commanding-in-Chief should not again be recommended.
4. Although an allotment is given it should not be taken for granted that approval will be given to all the recommendations submitted. A selection of these will be made at D.H.Q.
