During the attack on PERONE on 1st September 1918 he brought forward ammunition, water, and rations to the Front Line under very heavy artillery and machine gun fire. Once when his ration party was all wounded he collected stragglers from all Units and stretcher bearers returning from the R.A.P., and formed a carrying party from these. He continued this work throughout the whole night displaying remarkable courage and initiative.
