<u>LEGION D'HONNEUR.</u> (Chevalier)	1.	Officers of the rank of Lt.Col. and below. Officers holding temp. rank above Lt.Col. should not be submitted.
<u>MEDAILLE MILITAIRE.</u>	1 2.	Other Ranks. For gallantry in action.
<u>CROIX DE GUERRE.</u>	2.	Other Ranks . For services in action.
<u>MEDAILLE D'HONNEUR.</u> <u>Avec Claives.</u>		
En Argent.	-	N.C.O's only.
En Bronze.	-	Privates only. This decoration will be awarded for devotion to duty in a theatre of war i.e. for services usually rewarded with the M.S.M.

Recommendations should be submitted in order of merit.

The usual conditions of award are to be held to apply in this case, viz: no one, who has already received a foreign decoration during the present campaign, will again be selected.
