	53rd Battalion (att. 14th A.I. Brigade H.Q.)		Lieut. Anthony Claud WOOLRYCH.	For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during the period 16/17th September and 11th November 1918. During the operations North of BELLOCOURT, as Brigade Intelligence Officer, Lieut. WOOLRYCH made most difficult reconnaissances forward bringing back the most valuable information on which further successful operations were made. His work during the difficult times of April on the VILLERS BRETTONEUX sector was of the highest order and, although severely gassed prior to the attack on the village on the 24th April, continued on duty until eventually evacuated. His continuous conscientious work and fearless devotion to duty have been most marked and an excellent example to all. Rank, Name and Unit have been checked with Staff and Regimental List of November 1918, and are certified correct.
