In the attack of 3rd. May 1917, this N.C.O. egain showed great courage and devotion to duty. After effecting an entry into the enemy's trench, he time and again rallied his men during the bembing duel. On two occasions when progress along the trench was stopped by the enemy, he led bombing parties over the open. During the succeeding day and night he did particularly fine work in carrying forward bombs and S.A.A.
