When the objectives had been obtained he led a bombing party along an emposed flank of the second objective and drove the enemy back fully a hundred yards. He held on until no further bombs were available. He then attempted to deal with the enemy by charging over the top but most of his comrades were immediate -ly shot down by Machine Gun fire. He still held on however, gathered up German bombo lying about the trenches and returned to the attack. When the end came and all supplies of amounition were exhausted he made a dash for freedom across bullet swept "No Man's Land" and called on the men with him to do likewise. He is strongly recommended for high distinction. Sergeant Cusuaxs 16th BATTH. During the operation against the HINDENBURG 1794 MM Henry Leolie .. Line, on the morning of the 11th april 1917 he showed great coolness and excellent leadership CHOULES in ateadying his men and keeping them well in hand during the advance. In the enemy trenches his organization of the counter bomb work went far towards enabling us to hold on as long as we did. Throughout the whole operation he displayed a magnificent courage and devotion to duty. He is recommended for distinction.
