9/10/18	9 <sup>TH</sup> A.L.H. REGIMENT.	LIEUT COLONEL	William, Henry SCOTT C.M.G., D.S.O.	On 2 <sup>nd</sup> of October 1918, while the Brigade was bivouaced near DUMA a report was received at 0920 that a large column of enemy was moving across the front of the Brigade to enter the foothills at KUBBET-1. ASRAFI. The Brigade was at once ordered out in pursuit. This officer got his Regiment away in particularly quick time and, moving at the trot & gallop, a distance of 6 miles, headed the enemy off, drew swords, charged & captured the whole column consisting of 1450 Turks (including 318 Cavalry) 26 Machine guns 1 Mountain gun, 2 77mm. Field Guns, 12 automatic rifles. If this advance Regiment had been 20 minutes later the enemy could have gained the entrance to the foothills & could have easily have kept the Brigade off with the machine guns & Artillery they had & so escaped. At JENIN on 20-9-18 as vanguard commander this officer acted with the utmost vigour, determination & judgment & his Squadron played a very prominent part in the capture of the town & the prisoners & material it contained. At JISR BENAT YAKUB on 27-9-18 after firing the fog led his Squadron in the semi-darkness & in face of heavy fire in a charge against the enemy's position which he captured after a severe melee. He displayed great courage, dash & throughout set a magnificent example. 50 Germans with 3 machine guns and 2 Field Guns were captured. At DUMA on 1/10/18 again did splendid work with his Squadron which ably led by himself brushed aside all obstacles, pushed on at the gallop, cut off and surrounded the retreating enemy including 81 Officers & 547 men.
