AT TIBERIAS on 25-9-18, when his Squadron was sent on in advance of the Brigade to reconnoitre, he showed great initiative, and on finding the place lightly held he made his dispositions, quickly capturing the town & some German & Turkish prisoners & motor & horse transport. The information sent back enabled the advance to proceed more quickly than was anticipated. Again at a hill near SASA on 29-9-18, he showed great example & dash when leading two Squadrons against the enemy who had been holding up the column for some hours. Through this, the position was quickly cleared, 5 machine guns being captured, & the way made clear for the Brigade to advance. In both cases this officer's work proved most valuable.	O. Robert Henry BORDRIDGE	At a hill near SASA on 29-9-18, when the enemy had been holding up the Brigade advance for some hours, this officer gallantly led a Squadron which he was commanding in a dismounted night attack against the enemy position and succeeded in clearing it, in conjunction with another Squadron, in half an hour. 9/10/18	9 th A.L.H. Regiment	LIEUT.	John, Malcolm MACDONALD.	For conspicuous gallantry & devotion to duty on the 20-9-18, whilst the Brigade was advancing from LETJUN to TENIN. A number of Turks were observed in bivouac in a wood about 1/2 mile south of the column. Lieut MACDONALD with two troops galloped around to the rear of the enemy & with the sword drove them out into the open where the entire force numbering 1800 men, 200 mules, 200 horses & a number of donkeys, surrendered. This officer showed great dash & initiative & set a fine example to his troops. Again on 2-10-18 he took two troops from the Bivouac area about 1 1/2 miles N.E. of DUMRA to seize the gap or pass at KHAN AYASH & prevent the enemy from reaching it. He moved 7 miles along the foot-hills in one hour & then charged the enemy advance guard Cavalry and caused them to surrender. He then occupied a position astride the road at KHUBBET I ASAFIR, thus protecting the flank of the rest of the Regiment from the North and prevented the escape of the enemy from the South West.
