When the attack was launched on the morning of 26th September, 1917, he led his patrol close up in rear of the assaulting waves "mopped-up" the position previously located, and captured 15 of the enemy and two machine guns. The prompt action of this patrol greatly assisted the assaulting waves and undoubtedly saved many casualties.</p> <p>Sgt.
