Twice during the early stages of the advance, he carried messages through the enemy's counter barrage and back across a swampy area heavily shelled and swept by machine gun fire. During the afternoon, a counter-attack was in progress and an urgent message had to be sent back. The shelling at this time was particularly severe, but Meade volunteered and succeeded in delivering the message to its destination. His work has been particularly good throughout.	Lieut.-Colonel. 		5378	Private Frederick Crowdy GIBSON.	For his gallant and conspicuous conduct during the attack near ZONEBROOK on the morning of 26th September, 1917. He repeatedly dressed and carried wounded and in doing so had to cross a swamp which was swept by machine gun fire and heavily shelled.
