During this period the men in the front line trenches had two hot meals each day, and tea three times per day.		
	49th Bn.		Captain HARRY LESLIE SWAIN.	Captain HARRY LESLIE SWAIN continues good service during period 13/16th August/16.		
	49th Bn.		Lieutenant EDWARD ERETH.	Lieut. EDWARD ERETH. Signalling Officer of the Bn. During period 13/16 Aug/16 whilst the Bn. was holding front line trenches, Lt. Erath kept open communication between Bn. Hdqrs & Coys, and also with Bn. to Pic. When his linesmen were done he ran a line himself to my advance Coy. at great personal risk under heavy enemy bombardment at the time. This line was run to save runners who had to take messengers through a very heavy bombardment.
