	4th LH Regt		Lieut James Daniel <u>HICKEY.</u>	This Officer acted as Second in Command of a Squadron throughout the operations and rendered valuable assistance at all times. At BEEREMBA on 31st Oct 1917 he was with the first attacking line and on the death of two troop leaders (coming into action), he personally led these troops at the redoubt in a bayonet attack and by his personal dash and daring put the issue beyond all doubt. He then rallied the men for further advance (dismounted) and swept right through all opposition. He took charge of all reinforcements and especially on 10th Dec 1917 through ETTINE to KEZAZE rendered excellent service on a wide front, whilst acting dismounted. He took charge of patrols and was responsible for much valuable information being received. Throughout the whole operations this officer's dash, gallantry and judgment have been most marked.
