At GAZA on 26th. March, he, with three others, while some distance away from the rest of the Sqn. took 17 of the enemy prisoner. On the afternoon of the 11th. July he watched from Pt. 510 the trench on WADI TELIEH opposite Pt. 460 and that night moved with the advance party of the raiding half Sqn. on that trench. On 18th. July he was one of the party of 12 that lay in ambush dismounted at EL BUGHAR well. On 30th. July he had charge of the advance party of the troop that left UN URGAN at 2310 to warn the 6th. L.H.
