On the 27th March 1913 his Squadran wasen the left of the position hold by 7th L.H. and he made several determined attempts to advence, but each effort was stopped by exceptionally heavy M.G. and rifle fire. About 1900 and Squadran of 6th L.H. made good a ridge of the left of Darton's Squadran and the latter at once advenced several hundred yards and began consolidating the line. About 1600 the 6th L.H. were forced back by very heavy fire and as Barton's Squadran danow being infilled the dis compelled to withdraw. He did this in a very quiet and orderly way and indoing so was wounded, but exing to the critical situation he remained on duty until he was again wounded, his leg being broken. During the trying day he displayed great caurage and set a fine example to all reckets his squadran.
