For bold and vigorous troop leading on the 7th November, 1917 at SHERIA. When attacking at this place, mounted, he led his troop, galloping up and capturing one trench. He then led his troop against another series of trenches and fought until the whole troop except two had become casualties. Although his left arm and thigh were shattered he continued fighting until exhausted from loss of blood.
