Shout was most conspicuous in carrying out reconnaissances, organizing men, and leading them under very heavy fire at a very critical stage. In order to direct the fire of his men, Lieut. Shout was compelled to leave cover and locate the enemy, who were firing heavily. Later the enemy came so close that a bayonet charge was necessary, and when the party emerged from the bush they came under a heavy machine gun and rifle fire.
