	5th Battalion 636		L/Cpl James CLARK.	<p>In the early evening of the 23rd August 1918 L/Cpl CLARK was in charge of limbers proceeding through ST. MARTIN WOOD to the Battalion dump. He made three separate trips through the wood to the dump. During the whole of the time there was an exceedingly severe enemy barrage of both H.E. and Gas shells. The horses were almost unmanageable, but under his skilful handling the limbers were brought through.</p> <p>This H.C.O.'s courage and determination were magnificent, and owing to his fearless disregard for his own personal safety the front line troops were supplied with rations and ammunition.</p> <p>This act was witnessed by the whole Company who gave unstinted praise and expressed highest admiration of L/Cpl CLARK's gallantry.</p>	LT.
