At POZIERES, FRANCE, on 25th. July 1916, after his Officer had been killed Cpl. GREGORY took charge of the Battalion bombers and continued the bomb fight for over 5 hours, holding off the enemy sufficiently to enable a barricade to be built, which materially assisted in the consolidation of trench O.C.1.

Cpl. GREGORY was on the GALLIPOLI Peninsula for over 7 months and did consistent good work.
