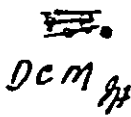

	5th Battalion	919	Sgt Harry KELLY	At ST. MARTIN WOODS, near FOUCAUCOURT, on the morning of the 23rd August, 1918, when the left flank of the attack was held up by heavy machine gun fire from a post about 70 yards in front, with fearless disregard for personal safety and under intense machine gun fire ran forward alone, rushed the post, bayoneted the numbers one of the guns and captured two guns and twelve men - thus enabling the attack to proceed. During the whole attack Sgt. KELLY showed magnificent dash and bravery in repeatedly going ahead of the line. On reaching the objective he again rendered great assistance in consolidating the position, taking charge of the platoon after his Officer had been wounded, and re-organised under machine gun fire.
