On the morning of the 9th May 1917 while the 8th-Battalion were bombing down the trench on the right of BULLECOURT, FRANCE, this H.C.O. was ordered to try and put some rifle grenades into the German sector of the trench which was about 200 yards in front. This was done but the gronades fell short by about 50 yards. Corporal MUNOERFORD gathered a mamber of rifle granades and in spite of German snipers, who were very active, edvanced to a shell hole in Ho Hans Land. He then fired grensdes into the Gorman bombing party with great success. The Cornans coased bombing and started to bomb along their own trench, thinking no doubt that they were taken in rear. Apl. HUNGERFORD was subsequently called upon to take charge of his platoon and in spite of a very heavy bonbardment carried out his duties with parked coolnoss and determination and set a fine example to his plateon which had suffered severe escualties.
