In spite of enemy wire, he succeeded in leading about 15 men into the right of the enemy trench. His report gives valuable information as to state of enemy lines. He, single handed, captured one of the enemy and handed him over to the Prisoners Guardsman. This prisoner afterwards escaped and was shot by the Guard in NO MANS LAND.
