August 26th 1914 - he was on the unit that landed at Gallipoli April 25th 1915 - was wounded May 8 - 1915 - returned to duty and left the Anzac 25th or Oct 2 - very ill - while in Hospital he wrote "Missing My friends was much admired at the time"
