Promoted Flight Lieut., 30/6/16; Flight Commander, 31/12/16. Given command of No. 1 Sqn., RNAS, 14/6/17. Promoted squadron commr., 30/6/17. Given command of No. 40 Squadron, ~~RNAS~~ R.A.F., 14/3/18. Promoted major, 1/4/18. Wounded in thigh and left leg, and admitted to hospital, 14/4/18. Discharged to duty, 18/4/18. Killed in action, 1/6/18. Served on Belgian coast, at Verdun, and on the Somme.
