In the latter he was appointed Assistant Scoutmaster before reaching 18 yrs. Transferred from Cadet Corps to Citizen Forces at 17 yrs & 8 months. On the outbreak of the war was called out for garrison duty with the artillery under Major Groom. Served 5 months & was relieved when his battery was relieved. At his parents' desire he reluctantly re-enlisted with any other member of the A.I.F. who had not distinguished himself. He left to return to his work in the Bank in the interval & notwithstanding his youth attained the rank of Ledger Keeper in an important branch. - Enlisted at 19 years Sailed with 18<sup>th</sup> reinforcement of 15<sup>th</sup> Batt. May 5<sup>th</sup> 1916. Served in Egypt & Western Front. Won Commendation & DCM at Tiensoort Apr 11<sup>th</sup> 1917.
