I now doubt if the surmise that he was killed by shell at No 1 Dressing Station while waiting doctor's attention (having been wounded in the leg) is correct. Pte Oakley was sent into action with him was taken prisoner. Since his return to Australia he has informed me that my own when volunteers were called for offered himself as platoon runner. Oakley was the last to see him alive.
