It comprised—1 warrant officer, 1 sergeant, 1 sergeant-artificer, 1 corporal, 2 lance-corporals, 10 privates; 16 in all, of whom 3 were struck off in South Africa.

Left Brisbane by rail on 30th January, 1902, and Sydney on 12th February, in the transport *Manchester Merchant*. Arrived at Durban on 17th March, and participated in operations in the Transvaal between 19th March and 31st May, 1902.

Embarked on 10th July in the transport Drayton Grange at Durban; called at Albany, 30th July, 1902, and arrived in Brisbane on 13th August, having taken Melbourne and Sydney en route.

Disbanded on 19th August, 1902.
