





From 1st to 7th September inclusive "AMOHINE" was secured at Naval Jetty Thursday Island.

- Departed Thursday Island 0700K 8th towing "BOONAROO". "BOONAROO" taken in tow by "GOOLGWAI" at 1130K and "AMOHINE" taken in tow by "DURRAWEEN" off Alpha Rock.
- Together with "SAMUEL BENBOW" proceed to Cairns by inside route. Arrived Cairns 1120K 15th and secured to Naval Wharf. Departed Cairns 0800K 16th under tow "DURRAWEEN" and in same company for Townsville. Arrived Townsville 0810K 17th secured to Naval Wharf. Departed Townsville 0800K 18th in tow "DURRAWEEN" for Gladstone. Arrived Gladstone 1630K 20th secured to Town Wharf. Departed Gladstone 0730K 21st in tow "DURRAWEEN" for Sydney.
- 4. Arrived Sydney 1115K 25th moored at Rushcutters Bay from 26th to 30th "AMOHINE" lay at moorings in Rushcutters Bay
- 5. Hull appears to be in fair condition. Last docked in November, 1944.
- Engine was condamned by Base Engineer Officer, Alexishafen Repair Base in July last. Is running but extremely unreliable.
- 7. The conduct, morale and health of crew leaves nothing to be desired.
- 8. Fire stations were exercised on 6th, 15th and 24th of the month.


