

13th	0745 1210 2300	Secured at No. 1 Berth TOWNSVILLE Shifted ship to No. 3 Berth alongside ARUNTA Slipped - proceeded to sea.
14th	0800	Joined S.S. MANGOLA (Convoy T.N. 92) as escort to PORT MORESBY - "SWAN" In company.
