2. Proceeded from Chapmans Dockyard, Balmaon to Garden Island A.M. 3rd September to have the flue of the new oil stove altered so as to give better draught. Returned to Garden Island P.M. 8th ..

P.M.13th. to A.M. 18th. transported stores around Sydney 30 Harbour for N.S.O. Garden Island.

Load cargo at No. 8 wharf Walsh Bay on 21st .. 4.

Sailed A.M. on 23rd. for Coffs Harbour in company with 5. G.P.V. 958, arrived P.M. 23rd..

P.M. 23rd fire started in the galley caused through insufficient packing behind iron plates at the back of the stove. Had to cut through the after bulkhead of the galley with an aze before extinguishing the fire.

Sailed A.M. 24th. for Brisbane arrived P.M. 25th .. 7.

8.A.M. A.M. 26th. Dockyard workmen commenced making damage good and fitting rotary cowl to top of galley flue to assist the draught.

Health and efficiency of the ship's company was satisfactory; 9. but aggravated by filth and soot from galley stove, and meals being delayed by bad functioning of the stove.
