

REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS - JULY.

Submitted in accordance with C.C.N.O. 97/43 Report of Proceedings of H.M.A. H.D.M.L. 1161 for month of July, 1945.

- At 0615 on 1st July, M.D.M.L. 1161 slipped from Small Craft Base, Brisbane and proceeded to Sydney via Coffs Harbour, clearing Pile Light at 0719. Rating embarked for passage to H.M.A.S. "MATHEN FLINDERS" was put aboard that vessel at 1145 off Caloundra Head. Coffs Herbour was entered at 1745 following day, vessel securing to buoy at 1810
- At 0800 on 3rd July, H.D.M.L. 1161 proceeded to Sydney direct entering that port at 1018 on 4th July, securing at Rushcutter at 1158. This voyage was without incident.
- 4. For the remainder of July, vessel has remained alongside at Rushcutter. A complete refit is required, including Alterations & Additions and Defects in main and auxilliary engines, hull, fittings, etc. Lists of these have been submitted.





Submitted in accordance with C.C.N.O. 97/43 Report of Proceedings of H.M.A. H.D.M.L. 1161 for month of July, 1945.

- At 0615 on 1st July, H.D.M.L. 1161 slipped from Small Craft Base, Brisbane and proceeded to Sydney via Coffs Harbour, clearing Pile Light at 0719. Rating embarked for passage to H.M.A.S. "MATHEW FLINDERS" was put aboard that vessel at 1145 off Caloundra Head. Coffs Harbour was entered at 1745 following day, vessel securing to buoy at 1810,
- At 0800 on 3rd July, H.D.M.L. 1161 proceeded to Sydney direct entering that port at 1018 on 4th July, securing at Rushcutter at 1158. This voyage was without incident.
- For the remainder of July, vessel has remained alongside at Rushcutter. A complete refit is required, including Alterations & Additions and Defects in main and auxilliary engines, hull, fittings, etc. Lists of these have been submitted.
