### CONNECTING WITH COMMUNITIES

The Bravus Mining and Resources Community Partnership Program makes positive financial contributions to regional Queensland communities where we live and work. Each year, the Community Partnership Program offers four rounds of funding for community groups and not-for-profit initiatives, projects, programs and events. A maximum of \$10,000 per applicant is granted in each round.

### Eligibility

To be eligible, your business, group or association must be registered in one of the Local Government Areas listed below:

- Burdekin Shire Council
- Central Highlands Regional Council
- Charters Towers Regional Council
- Gladstone Regional Council
- Isaac Regional Council
- Livingstone Regional Council
- Mackay Regional Council
- Rockhampton Regional Council
- Townsville City Council
- Whitsunday Regional Council

Applicants must be a registered not-for-profit group or organisation based in Australia and possess an ABN that aligns with the registered name of the organisation.

Applications for grant funding must also align with at least one of Bravus' core community focus areas:

- Education and Skills Development (children and adults)
- Health
- Sustainable Communities
- Environmental Stewardship
- Social Welfare

### What is not eligible for funding?

- Organisations that operate for profit
- Projects or initiatives that discriminate on the basis of race, gender or lifestyle
- Religious or political activities including advocacy or lobbying
- Individuals participating in sporting events
- Travel costs for events or sporting trips
- Projects or programs that would ordinarily be funded by government
