



Volunteer Role Description: **Motorcycle Marshal (Route Services)**

Brief Description	Motorcycle Marshals are out on route assisting the Route Manager. You must hold a valid motorcycle license. You will need to supply your own motorcycle. You will be responsible for monitoring riders on the route and reporting any issues or accidents to the Route Manager. You will also be required to provide immediate assistance to rider accidents.

Location & Times	Various locations on course Sunday 14 October, 5:00am – 12 noon (maximum – more than likely will be shorter, based on course zone allocation)

Experience/ Skills Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ability to work as part of a team and independently• Excellent communication skills• Ability to work in a fast-paced environment• Ability to follow instructions• Ability to think clearly, act responsibly under all conditions and respond quickly to changing situations• A friendly and approachable demeanor• Radio communication skills (desired)
General Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You will be interacting with riders and other volunteers• Volunteers should come prepared for all weather elements (i.e. dress in layers, bring waterproof clothing and sunscreen)• Comfortable closed toe footwear is essential• All volunteers are required to sign in and out during any period of volunteering• You will be required to attend one briefing session prior to the event• A safety vest will be issued to you and needs to be returned at the end of the event• A detailed map of the route and your zone will be emailed to you prior to the event• Not all customers might be happy, so please be patient and remain courteous• Any serious problems or concerns should be referred to the Route Manager
Sun Exposure	High – Motorcycle Marshals will often be in the sun and without facilities, so sun protection and proper hydration is important
