ANTI-DUMPING LEGISLATION PASSES PARLIAMENT

BlueScope welcomes the all-party support of the new Customs Amendment (Anti-Dumping Measures) Bill 2017 that passed through Parliament yesterday.

We are very pleased that Assistant Minister Laundry and the Government have recognised this gap in Australia's anti-dumping system and have moved promptly to close it by working with Labor and the cross bench to pass these amendments to the legislation. The amendments bring Australia more closely into line with the anti-dumping rules of other comparable jurisdictions and will help ensure Australian manufacturers have access to timely and effective redress from injurious dumping, in line with Australia's WTO rights and obligations.

The Anti-Dumping Commission will now need to consider implementation of these amendments. Once this has occurred we will evaluate the nature and timing of any benefits for BlueScope's Australian business.
