

EFFECTIVE COMMUNITY BRAINSTORMING

"The best way to get great ideas is to have lots of ideas"

Brainstorming is useful for:

- Generating lots of ideas in a short period
- Encouraging lateral and creative thinking
- Expanding, 'piggy backing' or 'leapfrogging' on the ideas of others
- Helping participants to temporarily suspend judgement or criticism
- Helping shy individuals to participate more effectively.

Rules for Brainstorming:

- Old disputes, feuds and ideologies should be left at the door!
- The goal is quantity - as many ideas as possible. List every idea anyone has
- Defer judgement - no criticism; no negativity; evaluation comes later
- Keep ideas short
- Anything goes - wild ideas are great
- Piggy backing on another's idea is allowed and encouraged
- Do not worry about spelling or repetition as ideas are recorded
