



## ***ENTRANT'S/FINALISTS EXPECTED DUTIES***

Please note duties are subject to change

- Volunteer a minimum of two hours at a campdraft or other community event. (May be verified by CLF)
- Promote the CLF and their Charities at local campdrafts or other events at entrant's discretion.
- Wearing CLF finalist sash and with consent of committees, participating in presentation ceremonies, Flag bearing at campdrafts and other promotional events.
- Participate in an interview with the CLF YAQ judging panel, covering areas such as:
  - Entrants experiences during the Quest
  - Considerations on the direction of campdrafting for the future
  - How our industry could be improved
  - Animal welfare issues and how they affect our industry
- Entrant to demonstrate a knowledge of at least one of the CLF current charities
- Display how the Entrant promoted the CLF and their Charities during the Quest (eg in their local community, local campdraft, online, held an information or awareness event, stall, public speaking)
- If available attend and assist at CLF promotional stands during Warwick Gold Cup.
- Compulsory attendance at Nutrien Classic event usually Wednesday to Sunday morning in the final week of the Nutrien event in Tamworth.
- Perform official CLF duties during CLF Promotional events during the Quest.
- Attend/assist with practice session for flag bearing nights for all Quest Entrants and co-ordinate practice sessions for Quest Entrants before flag bearing nights (finals and presentations) and take part if flag bearing if needed.
- Attend presentation of winner and runner up during CLF Ladies Luncheon (Luncheon tickets available for purchase separately at entrant's own cost).
- Attend CLF Mentoring workshop.
- Attend rostered/scheduled CLF events during the Nutrien Classic Event

## **CLF YOUNG AMBASSADOR WINNER AND RUNNER UP EXPECTED DUTIES**

### **Please note duties are subject to change**

The winner and runner up will be required to remain in Tamworth and be available to perform official duties of the CLF, unless granted an exemption by CLF. Other finalists may leave Tamworth after judging, however they are welcome and encouraged to remain to assist with the CLF promotions and activities

- Travel cost and accommodation are the responsibility of the entrant.
- The winner and runner up act as ambassadors for CLF during their reign and are expected to promote the CLF and the Young Ambassador Quest during the following year.
- Expected to wear the sashes during official duties and while assisting at the CLF promotional stand at Nutrien Classic.
- Participate (with committee consent) in campdraft/event award ceremonies throughout the year and general promote the CLF.
- Flag bearers at campdrafts and promotional events that may arise.
- Attend the following year's Young Ambassador Quest presentation ceremony (exemptions can be granted)
- Assist and encourage the entrants for the following year's Quest.
- Provide product review of prizes to sponsors for use in the sponsors advertising material, social media and websites.
- Be available for promotional photographs for CLF and sponsors (if required)
- The winner and runner up are expected to fulfill their promotional obligations to any sponsor offering prizes and an ambassadorship/advertising package. *Please consider whether any personal sponsors you may have may be in direct conflict with promotional/advertising obligations as part of the prize package for the Quest.*
- Attend/assist with flag carrying practice sessions and co-ordinate flag carrying nights and well as carry flags in there are insufficient numbers.
