DESCRIPTION

When in Sydney do what the locals do and travel on the harbour highway. The official Sydney Harbour Explorer travels between the Harbour's famous landmarks and allows passengers to disembark and reboard as they choose. Pass options range from 1 or 2 calendar days, to a single loop. The Rocket Sightseeing pass is designed for those short on time and includes a single loop of the Harbour from Circular Quay to Manly. Along the way enjoy a warm Captain Cook welcome and a fun, fascinating commentary where you can pick up hints on how to make the most of your time in Sydney that only the locals know. The circuit takes approximately 80 minutes and departs regularly throughout the day from Circular Quay between 9:30am and 3:00pm.
