What: To make room at our table and seek room at other tables to include all in the good news

How: Table church, Identifying other tables to sit at, listening to Holy Spirit, Prayer

Missions

What: To develop a heart for missions embracing local, national and international concerns

How: Policy, team, developing relationships and partnerships, Holy Spirit, Prayer
