Precis re Rev. E.J. Plenderleith
Newtown Baptist Church

1954 Wire Fence Leavour St., side adjoining the Sunday School Hall - Dept. of Lands advised.

1955 Subsidy of £30 granted to Newtown Baptist Church for cyclone wire fence to be erected between Church and Park.

Dept. of Lands advised encroachment of our Park Land by fence by letter of 7.11.55

Correspondence continued between Trust and Newtown Baptist Church re fence. The fence was located in correct position on 24th August, 1956.

October 1956 £30 granted to Newtown Baptist Church for replacing of fence.

1958 Request by Newtown Baptist Church for erection of childrens' Play Park within bounds of Rest Park together with conveniences. The Minister for Lands notified re Play Area and they replied ^{on 20.3.58} that no part of Campdown Memorial Rest Park can be used for the establishment of a childrens' playground with all its associated equipment.

On 1.4.58 the following were advised of the Ministers Reply - The Hon. E. O'Dea, Mr. Gabriel, Ald. A.J. Gabriel, Ald. H.K. Dwyer, Mr. G. Smith, Ald. A.K. Dunn, Mr. Rev. Bishop W.G. Hilliard, Rev. E.J. Plenderleith.

The Rev. E.J. Plenderleith on 1.4.58 complained of St. Stephen's Church Hall drainage being carried off into Park. A reply stated that the drainage pipes were laid without permission and the Trust would be advised of this matter.
