Post hard copies of supporting documentation – CGGS scholarship cover sheet, Birth Certificate, Certificate of Australian Citizenship or Permanent Residency Visa (if born overseas), latest School Report, NAPLAN Report, 2 current passport photos, completed Music / Academic Scholarship Application Form & Music Audition Form, copies of music exam certificates.
4. Attend the Scholarship Interactive Evening, Scholarship Examination and Music Audition at CGGS.

Music Auditions: Wednesday 13 February 2019 or Friday 15 February 2019 held at CGGS Senior School Music Department, 2 Torrington Street, Canterbury.

IMPORTANT: Music candidates will be contacted by the Music Administrator and notified of their audition date and time by email once all supporting documentation is received. **Candidates must provide an accompanist as necessary.** A warm-up room will be available for use *20 minutes before* the scheduled audition time.

IMPORTANT: Music candidates will be contacted by the Music Administrator and notified of their audition date and time by email once all supporting documentation is received. **Candidates must provide an accompanist as necessary.** A warm-up room will be available for use *20 minutes before* the scheduled audition time.

All Music candidates are also required to sit for the CGGS Scholarship Examination and attend the CGGS Scholarship Interactive Evening.

Audition performed with one instrument:

- > Two pieces, contrasting in style and tempo, no longer than 8 minutes in total.
- > A selection of technical examples in scales, arpeggios or technical exercise which demonstrate facility, control, coordination and tonal qualities. These examples nominated by the candidate should be in at least 3 different key tonalities, including major and minor.

Audition performed with two instruments:

- > Two pieces on main instrument, contrasting in style and tempo, plus one short piece or excerpt on the second instrument. Candidates may be requested to begin at a significant section or conclude early. Total performance time no longer than 10 minutes.
- > A selection of technical examples in scales, arpeggios or technical exercise which demonstrate facility, control, coordination and tonal qualities. These examples nominated by the candidate should be in at least 3 different key tonalities including major and minor.

Candidates will also be required to perform the following at the Music Audition:

- > A short sight-reading excerpt
- > A selection of aural tests, appropriate to the level of study

Note: Aural testing will not necessarily be based on AMEB type examples.
