Camberwell Girls Grammar School offers Music / Academic Scholarships for entry at Years 5, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. Scholarships are tenable as follows: Years 5 to 12; Years 7 to 12; Years 8 to 12, Years 9 to 12; Years 10 to 12, Years 11 to 12. Music/Academic Scholarships are awarded on the basis of a candidate's Music Audition, scholarship examination results, participation in the Scholarship Interactive Evening, latest School Report, NAPLAN report and a scholarship interview. Any student applying for a Music / Academic Scholarship will also be considered for an Academic Scholarship.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > Candidates must be Australian or New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents in Australia. Candidates are required to provide a copy of their Australian or New Zealand Birth Certificate and a copy of their Australian Citizenship Certificate or Permanent Residency visa if born overseas.
- > Eligible Camberwell Girls Grammar School students may apply for the Music / Academic Scholarship
- > Students are to be age and year level-appropriate
- > Candidates should be proficient in their instrument(s) at the required AMEB or equivalent level for their year, see music prerequisites below
- > Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination

#### STEP 3 / SUBMIT MUSIC AUDITION FORM & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Submit the following documents online using the 'Music / Academic Scholarship Audition Form' via the following link <https://cggs.vic.edu.au/scholarships/> at the time you apply online for the scholarship exam. Applications close Wednesday 5 February 2020, 5.00pm.

- > Birth Certificate
- > Australian Citizenship Certificate or Permanent Resident Visa (if born overseas)
- > Latest School Report
- > NAPLAN Report
- > Copy of latest music exam certificate for auditioning instrument(s) eg. AMEB, ABRSM, Trinity College London etc.
- > Completed Music / Academic Scholarship Audition Form (online)



#### **STEP 4 / ATTEND SCHOLARSHIP EVENTS AT CGGS**

- > Sit the Scholarship Exam – Saturday 29 February 2020
- > Attend the Scholarship Interactive Evening – Thursday 27 February 2020
- > Attend your Music Audition – date and time to be notified by the CGGS Music Department once documentation is received
  - 25 February 2020 or 28 February 2020 held at CGGS Senior School Music Department
  - Music candidates are to provide their own accompanist

#### **MUSIC PREREQUISITES**

Music / Academic Scholarship candidates should have achieved the required AMEB standard (or equivalent) for the year level they are applying for:

##### **Year 5**

Keyboard Grade 4  
Strings Grade 2  
Other Instruments Grade 2

##### **Years 7 & 8**

Keyboard Grade 6\*  
Strings Grade 6  
Woodwind Grade 5  
Brass Grade 4  
Other Instruments Grade 4

##### **Years 9, 10 & 11**

Keyboard Grade 7  
Strings Grade 7  
Woodwind Grade 6  
Brass Grade 5  
Other Instruments (including Voice\*) Grade 5

*\* Preferably together with orchestral instrument, minimum Grade 3. Candidates of Brass and Double Reed instruments are particularly invited to apply, regardless of grade level.*

- *Voice auditions accepted for students entering Years 9, 10 & 11 only.*

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#### **MUSIC AUDITION REQUIREMENTS**

##### **Audition performed with one instrument:**

- > Two pieces, contrasting in style and tempo, no longer than 8 minutes in total.
- > A selection of technical examples in scales, arpeggios or technical exercise which demonstrate facility, control, coordination and tonal qualities. These examples nominated by the candidate should be in at least 3 different key tonalities, including major and minor.

##### **Audition performed with two instruments:**

- > Two pieces on main instrument, contrasting in style and tempo, plus one short piece or excerpt on the second instrument. Candidates may be requested to begin at a significant section or conclude early. Total performance time no longer than 10 minutes.
- > A selection of technical examples in scales, arpeggios or technical exercise which demonstrate facility, control, coordination and tonal qualities. These examples nominated by the candidate should be in at least 3 different key tonalities including major and minor.

Candidates will also be required to perform the following at the Music Audition:

- > A short sight-reading excerpt
- > A selection of aural tests, appropriate to the level of study

Note: Aural testing will not necessarily be based on AMEB type examples.



**IMPORTANT:** Music candidates will be contacted by the Music Administrator and notified of their audition date and time by email once all supporting documentation is received. Candidates must provide an accompanist as necessary. A warm-up room will be available for use 20 minutes before the scheduled audition time. All Music candidates are also required to sit for the CGGS Scholarship Examination and attend the CGGS Scholarship Interactive Evening.

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)**

> All matters pertaining to Music / Academic Scholarships remain confidential.

#### **Submitting Documentation**

To be considered for a Music / Academic Scholarship you must submit the documentation outlined in (Step 3) online by Wednesday 5 February 2020 using the Music / Academic Scholarship Form. You are not required to submit supporting documents using the online Academic Scholarship Form.

#### **Testing Day Information**

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest via email in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday or Tuesday prior to testing day.

#### **Results**

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted by the School for an interview with the Principal / Head of School, generally 2 to 3 weeks after the testing. A comprehensive Edutest scholarship report will be posted to unsuccessful candidates at the end of Term 1 or beginning of Term 2 2020 once the scholarship process is completed.

#### **Scholarship Terms & Conditions**

Music / Academic Scholarships apply to tuition fees and music tuition (private music lessons x 30-minute tuition over 16 lessons per semester) on the student's primary instrument. It does not cover composite fees, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements.

> Music / Academic Scholarship recipients are expected to be active participants in co-curricular Music programs.

Scholarship holders must complete their education at CGGS and maintain a high standard of academic achievement, participate in the life of the School and be a positive member of the school community. The performance of each student is reviewed annually. In the event of a student's withdrawal prior to completing their education, the full value of the Scholarship up to that time will be repayable to the School.

> No Scholarship holder may hold more than one Scholarship.

> A sibling discount does not apply to a Scholarship holder.

#### **Value of Scholarships**

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
