Camberwell Girls Grammar School offers Principal's Scholarships for entry at Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to students who are able to demonstrate the School's values of Integrity, Commitment, Respect, Hope and Courage in their co-curricular and community involvements. Refer to Principal's Scholarship application requirements over the page.

Scholarships are tenable as follows: Years 7 to 12; Years 8 to 12, Years 9 to 12; Years 10 to 12, Years 11 to 12. Principal's Scholarships are awarded on the basis of a candidate's Principal's Scholarship Application, scholarship examination results, participation in the Scholarship Interactive Evening, latest School Report, NAPLAN report and a scholarship interview.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > Candidates must be Australian or New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents in Australia. Candidates are required to provide a copy of their Australian or New Zealand Birth Certificate and a copy of their Australian Citizenship Certificate or Permanent Residency visa if born overseas.
- > Eligible Camberwell Girls Grammar School students may apply for the Principal's Scholarship
- > Students are to be age and year level-appropriate
- > Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination

Testing Day Information

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest via email in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday or Tuesday prior to testing day.

Results

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted by the School for an interview with the Principal / Head of School, generally 2 to 3 weeks after the testing. A comprehensive Edutest scholarship report will be posted to unsuccessful candidates at the end of Term 1 or beginning of Term 2 2020 once the scholarship process is completed.

Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Principal's Scholarships apply to tuition fees and do not cover composite fees, private music lessons, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements all of which are the responsibility of parents.

> Scholarship holders are expected to complete their education at CGGS and maintain a high standard of academic achievement, participate in the life of the School and be a positive member of the school community. The performance of each student is reviewed annually. In the event of a student's withdrawal prior to completing their education, the full value of the Scholarship up to that time will be repayable to the School.

> No Scholarship holder may hold more than one Scholarship.

> A sibling discount does not apply to a Scholarship holder.

Value of Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
