Mount Gambier Christmas Parade 2019 GUIDELINES

The 2019 Mount Gambier Christmas Parade will begin promptly at **11:00am**, departing from the marshalling area on the corner of Crouch Street and Commercial Street East, known as the Federal Hotel corner.

Deadline for entries is 5:00 pm on **Thursday 31 October 2019**. Late entries are not guaranteed acceptance.

KEY DATES TO REMEMBER

Float & Driver briefing: *Monday 11 November 2019 at 6:00pm at City Hall* (enter via Cave Garden). A representative and the <u>driver</u> of each entry <u>must attend</u> the briefing night. Positions in the Parade and marshalling instructions will be given at this meeting.

• Float Assembly: Saturday 16 November 2019 from 8:30am. All entries must be present at the marshalling area from 8:30am to line up in parade order. If you need to park your vehicle before 8:30am, please park on Anthony Street until the road is clear. Please seek out the Head Marshal, who will be stationed at the intersection of Commercial Street East and Crouch Street corner known as 'Federal Hotel Corner' at 10:00am, if you need assistance with your float or the number order your float is positioned for the start.

Awards Presentation Night: *Tuesday 26 November 2019 at 5:30pm* at City Hall (enter via Cave Garden). Award winners will be invited to attend.

Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

CREATIVITY, EFFORT, VISUAL APPEAL, ENTHUSIASM & ENGAGEMENT and RECYCLE FOCUS.

Entrants are eligible for any award with only one prize awarded per entry. Prize allocation is completely at the judges' discretion.

CRITERIA FOR ENTRIES

- All entrants must relate to or be in keeping with the Christmas Festive Season, Christmas Theme or Community Celebration. The idea of the Parade is to have FUN, and for the community to engage in the event.
- There is only ONE Father Christmas no other Parade participants including band members are permitted to wear Father Christmas costumes.
- Float leaders to please report to the Head Marshal on Parade day who will be stationed at the intersection of Commercial Street East and Crouch Street corner known as 'Federal Hotel Corner' at 10:00am.
- All floats have been allocated an assembly area as per Parade Running Order. Floats may take their position in the assembly area from 8:30am on Parade Day.
- Entries are <u>not to be used as an advertisement</u> or promotional opportunity of a commercial nature.
- The Parade Advisory Group retain the right to modify any aspect of the float/presentation, and the right to position entrants in the parade as they see fit, giving consideration to content, theme and impact on other participants.
- The Parade Advisory Group is continually striving to improve the standard and quality of entries and encourages groups to consider the use of lower floats or smaller trucks (in lieu of higher semitrailers) with more / alternatively walking participants to offer younger members of the audience better viewing.
- The movement of the Parade will be controlled by the Head Marshal and Marshals spaced along Commercial Street wearing green Hi Vis vests. Participants must adhere to their directions at all times.
- All entries to <u>maintain a 20 metre distance</u> between each float at all times during the Parade.
- All entrants are requested NOT to stop the flow of the Parade unless absolutely necessary. Please

- no 'demonstrations' in front of the official party or for the benefit of cameras etc.
- All vehicles travelling to and from the Parade must be road registered and obey all road rules. If required an "unregistered permit" for the day may be obtained from Service SA at 11 Helen Street. This form (MR2) can be downloaded prior from www.sa.gov.au
- Throwing of any item from a float is prohibited, as it may encourage young people to run out in front of moving vehicles. This includes the discharge of water from water pistols.
- Entries are encouraged to continue activities and music on the floats to Vansittart Park Oval entry gates.
- If young children are aboard vehicles, please make sure they receive adequate adult supervision and that reasonable restraining measures are in place, i.e., a rope barrier, straps, hay bales or decorated fence.
- By entering in the Parade you agree to the City of Mount Gambier taking photographs and video footage of your entry, including individuals involved. You further accept that the City of Mount Gambier have the authority to publish and use this material for subsequent advertising and marketing purposes.
- No alcohol is to be consumed by any participants in the Christmas Parade or afterwards during the Party in the Park at the Cave Garden as the city centre is a designated Dry Zone. No alcoholic beverage containers are to be featured in float displays or vehicles.
- No smoking permitted on or near Parade entries or during the Parade & Party in the Park.
- Each float to have a fire extinguisher and first aid kit.
- The City of Mount Gambier requires entrants to be covered by their own public liability insurance on the day of the Parade. If groups or individuals do not have public liability insurance, then they are required to inform organisers when submitting their entry form.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- The safety of yourself and others, including where you position participants on vehicles.
- How to prevent people and items accidentally falling from floats.
- The use of electrical appliances in all weather conditions. Appliances should be "tagged and tested" to comply with Australian Standards and be water resistant.
- Items and props should not pose a threat to participants or audience members.

PARKING & PARADE SAFETY AT VANSITTART PARK

Vansittart Park will be open from 9:30am to 10:00am on Parade Day, Saturday 16 November 2019 for the parking of those vehicles who need to assist in the unpacking of a Parade float once that float has arrived after the Parade. Each Parade entry will be issued with two (2) permits and those designated vehicles **MUST** park in the extreme North West corner, Western side of the oval surrounds. Permits are issued on Parade Briefing Night. No vehicles will be permitted to enter Vansittart Park after 10:00am. All vehicles are to arrive and depart from Vansittart Park via the Victoria Terrace gate.

The Parade Advisory Group is working to achieve continuous improvement in respect of children being collected after participation in the Parade. No vehicles will be permitted to enter Vansittart Park after the Parade commences.

Parents or teachers are not permitted past the barrier zone to collect participants or children from their float.

Parents are encouraged to park off site and walk into the park via the pedestrian gateways as marked. They will be directed to the main oval by Marshalls in green vests where they can locate relevant collection point for their school.

Children are not permitted to be removed from floats until the float is parked in the designated area and stationery. Volunteer marshalls will escort nominated adults (issued with a pass) or teachers/adults present on floats to offload children from floats and guide them to the main oval area for collection by parents or teachers. As per example below each school to display a banner for parents to easily identify collection point for their children. Each school to have containers available for students to hand in any items used during the parade.



EXIT INSTRUCTIONS

All Parade entries will travel along Commercial Street and then turn right into Wehl Street North before turning left through Federation Arch and into Vansittart Park.

All foot traffic must either continue straight onto the Oval via the Pedestrian gate or turn left upon entering Vansittart Park. For safety reasons, **pedestrians must NOT follow floats** instead enter Vansittart Park via gate directed by volunteers onto oval due to moving vehicles.

All vehicle entries must turn right when entering Vansittart Park and park their vehicles according to the direction given by marshals or SES volunteers before allowing participants to disembark on the right-hand side of the float.

All vehicles must **EXIT** Vansittart Park through the Victoria Terrace gate and must turn RIGHT onto Victoria Terrace and turn **LEFT** onto Jubilee Highway West.

No left turn will be permitted onto Victoria Terrace from Vansittart Park.
