

# Works Notice

## Roma Street station site

**Preparation for construction of the new underground station at Roma Street continues, including demolition and site establishment activities throughout December.**

### Demolition underway

Demolition works are underway at Hotel Jen and the East Tower. Upcoming activities include:

- Continuing to disconnect utility services and remove internal fittings and fixtures
- Installing scaffolding around the buildings
- Safely removing any hazardous materials found in the buildings. These activities will be carried out in accordance with regulatory requirements
- Demolition work using large equipment such as excavators with hammer and grabber attachments
- Removing demolition waste using trucks.

An increase in noise can be expected during these activities. Access to Roma Street station (rail and bus services) will be maintained during these activities.

### Closure of Roma Street footbridge

Due to the demolition of Hotel Jen and the Brisbane Transit Centre, the footbridge over Roma Street will be permanently closed in early 2020.

Alternative pedestrian access will be available via Roma Street signalised crossings.

### Preparation for tunneling activities

Work will continue on the corner of Roma Street and Parkland Boulevard to prepare for excavating the tunnel access shaft. The shaft will provide access for equipment and personnel to build the underground station. Activities at the site will include:

- Continuing excavation, including rock breaking, to prepare the site
- Installing timber hoarding (fencing) around the site
- Preparing the ground and pouring concrete for the base of the acoustic shed and other tunnelling support infrastructure (e.g. water treatment plant)
- Installing various utility services needed to operate the site.

### Utility investigations continue

Utility investigation and relocation works will continue in and around the site, including:

- Excavation using a vacuum truck to identify existing underground utility services
- Relocating underground utility services between the Brisbane Transit Centre and Queensland Rail carpark.

### Site shutdown

The Roma Street station site will be closed between **Monday 23 December 2019 and Sunday 5 January 2020** for Christmas and New Year holidays. Intermittent site inspections and maintenance will occur during this period.

### Work hours

Works will generally occur between **6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Due to traffic restrictions some works will occur outside of these hours. We will notify nearby residents of any requirement for night works.

Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the planned start time to prepare for the day's activities.

### Upcoming night works

The following work will occur intermittently throughout December between **6:30pm and 6:30am**:

- Identifying and relocating utility services in the Brisbane Transit Centre
- Identifying and relocating existing underground utility services along Roma Street
- Geotechnical investigations in and around the site.

### What to expect

As a result of these activities you can expect:

- An increase in construction workers and vehicles in the area
- A potential increase in noise, dust and vibration. These impacts will be reduced as much as possible
- Temporary changed traffic conditions and minor traffic delays. Traffic control will be in place where required to maintain the safety of road users, the community and workers.

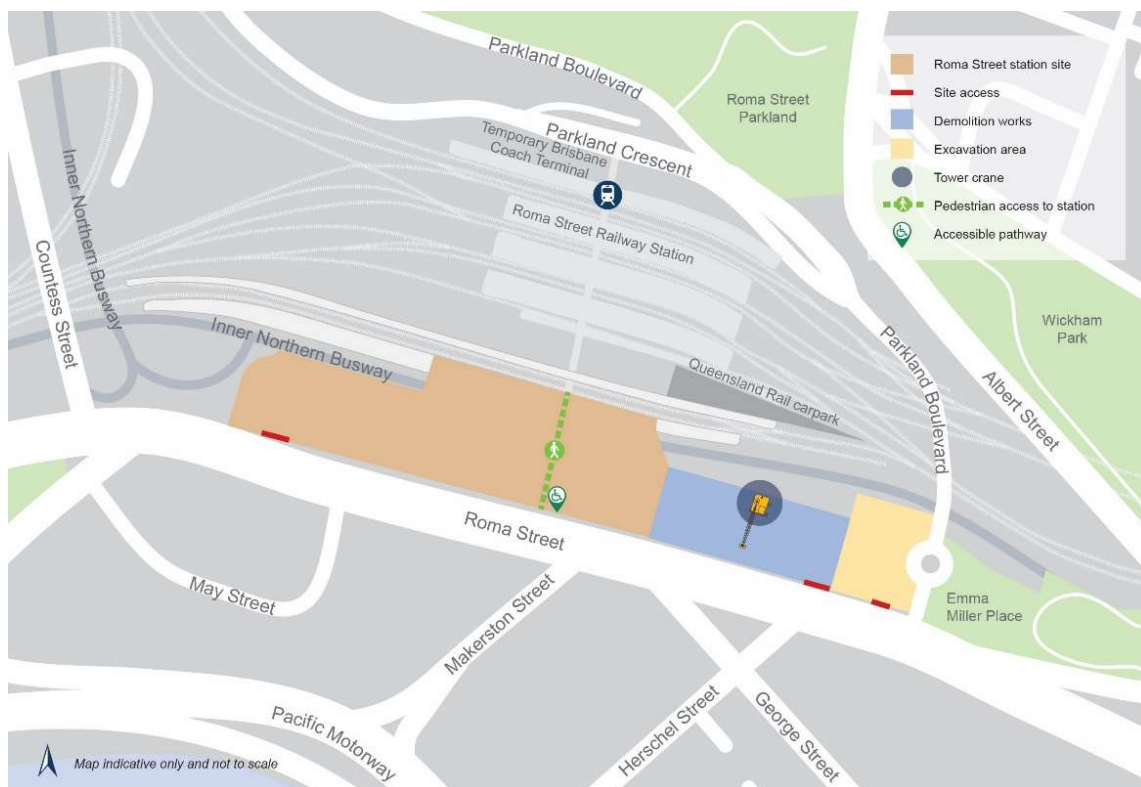
Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.
