Woolloongabba station construction update

Ongoing piling and earth works continuing at Woolloongabba for the Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) launch area and new underground station.

Details of work

During February, activities on site will include:

- Piling activities, including starting to break back the top of the piles using jackhammers and building the concrete capping beam
- Excavation of the TBM launch area and station box. Some excavated material will be re-used on site to build the access ramp and other site facilities, and the remainder will be removed from site by trucks via the Leopard Street exit
- Building platforms and pads for further piling and other site infrastructure. This will involve earthworks and the use of vibratory rollers
- Identifying and relocating existing underground utility services in and around the site
- Geotechnical investigations in and around the site
- Installing power and other utility services required for tunnelling and site operations.

Works will generally occur between **6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**, weather and construction conditions permitting. Some work may be carried out at night due to traffic restrictions and to maintain the safety of the community and our workers. Details of upcoming night works are detailed below. We will notify nearby residents prior to any night works.

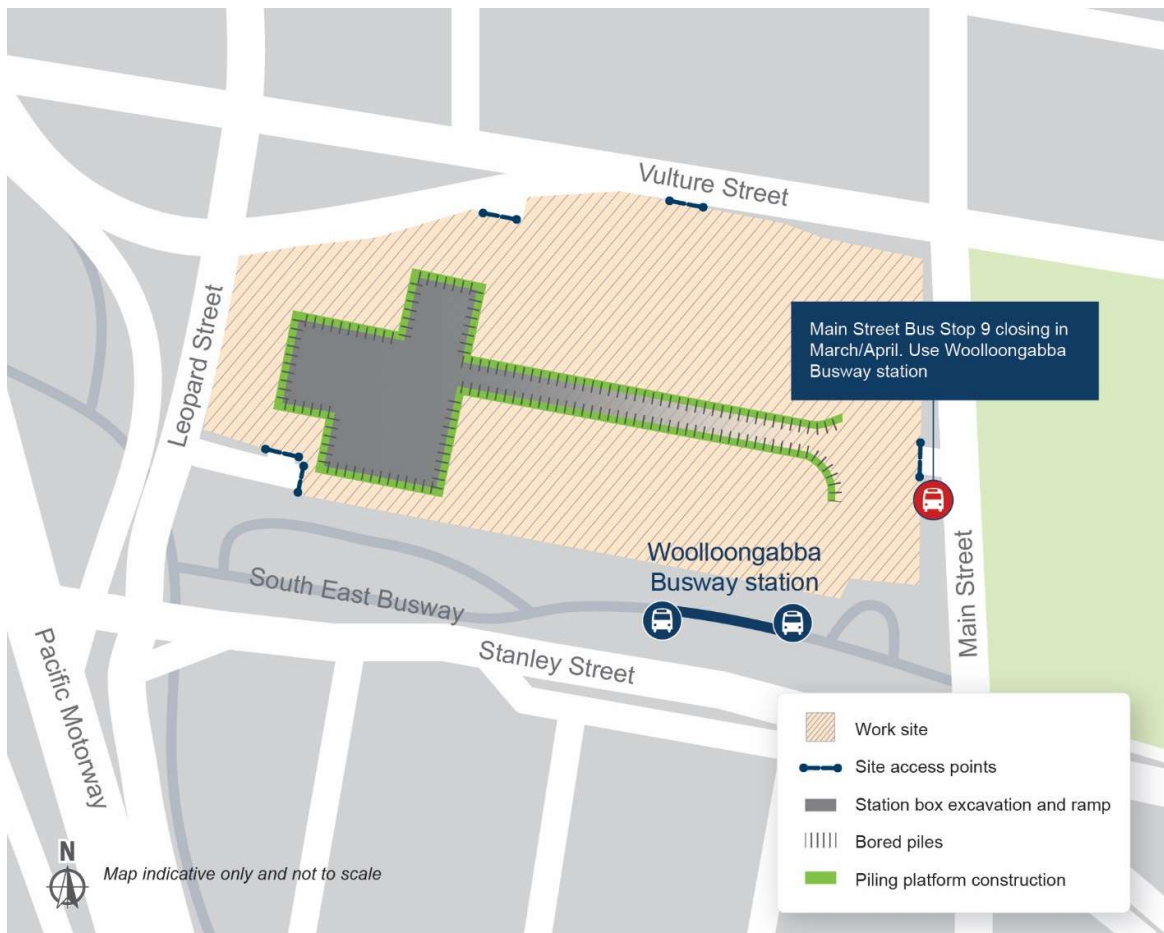
Upcoming night work

The following activities will occur intermittently in February between **6.30pm and 6:30am, Monday to Friday**:

- Installing traffic signage on roads surrounding the site
- Geotechnical investigations in and around the site
- Investigation and relocation of existing underground services on surrounding roads and footpaths
- Delivery and unloading of oversized machinery and materials.

Bus stop closure rescheduled – Main Street

The closure of bus stop 9 on Main Street at The Fiveways (Stop ID: 019053) has been rescheduled to March/April 2020 to coincide with the establishment of the Main Street entrance (Please see map overleaf). The closure is required due to the proximity of the bus stop to the site entry and to maintain the safety of the community. Commuters will be able to catch the bus from Platform Two at the Woolloongabba Busway. Signage will be installed at the bus stop in advance of the closure.



What to expect

- Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the planned start time to prepare for the day's activities
- An increase in construction workers and vehicles in the area
- A potential increase in noise, dust and vibration. These impacts will be reduced as much as possible
- Temporary changed traffic conditions and minor traffic delays. Traffic control will be in place where required to maintain the safety of road users, the community and workers.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site. Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

The Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations contractor CBGU D&C JV will deliver the underground tunnel and four new underground stations at Boggo Road, Woolloongabba, Albert Street, Roma Street and an upgrade to the Dutton Park station.
